



Privacy and Cookie Statement Quick Plug

This Privacy and Cookie Statement describes the personal data collected or generated (processed) when you use the Quick Plug website <quickplug.global> (“Site”) and how your personal data is used, shared and protected.

This Privacy and Cookie Statement applies only to the personal data we collect on this Site and not to any personal data that we collect through other methods or services, including websites owned or operated by our affiliates, vendors or partners.

Who Is Responsible for The Processing of Your Personal Data?

Quick Plug is the controller responsible for the processing of your personal data through the Site. We are a Dutch company, with registered address at Vlotlaan 145, 2681 TW Monster, the Netherlands.

What Personal Data We Collect and When?

Personal data you provide to us

We collect and store personal data that you choose to voluntarily provide to us, such as your contact details including name, address, email, telephone number and resume (which may include personal details such as gender, hometown, date of birth and image), when contacting us through the Site, ordering a hard copy catalog or applying for a job.

How Do We Use the Personal Data We Collect?

We use the personal data we collect through this Site to provide you with the services you requested. We also use the data collected to examine in which way we can adjust the Site to improve your visitor experience.

Sharing of Your Personal Data

We do not sell or otherwise disclose your personal data, except as described herein.

We may share job applications within the Quick Plug group worldwide to assess the job applications.

We may share your personal data with third party service providers we have retained to perform services on our behalf. We may use other companies to perform services on our behalf, including without limitation hosting or operating this Site and analysing data. We require these service providers by agreement to appropriately safeguard the privacy and security of personal data they process on our behalf.

We may disclose your personal data if we are compelled or required by law, to law enforcement authorities or other government officials, to protect or defend our legal rights, or to investigate, prevent or act regarding illegal activities, suspected fraud, or violations for the terms for using this Site or other applicable policies.

We also reserve the right to transfer your personal data if we sell or transfer all or a portion of our business assets.



Data Transfer

We may transfer the personal data we collect on this Site to other countries other those in which the data was originally collected. Such countries may not offer the same adequate level of protection as countries in the European Union / European Economic Area. When we transfer your personal data outside the European Union / European Economic Area, we will protect this data as described in this Privacy and Cookie Statement and ensure that the personal data is only transferred when there is an adequate level of protection or appropriate safeguards have been put in place.

Security

The security of your personal data is important to us, and we are committed to using reasonable technical, practical and organisation measures to protect the personal data we may collect through the Site.

Nonetheless, we cannot guarantee that communications between you and us or the data stored on this Site is secure.

Retention of your Personal Data

We retain your personal data for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes for which we collect it, except if required otherwise by law

Your Rights Related to Your Personal Data

You have the right to request: (i) access to your personal data; (ii) correction of your personal data if it is incomplete or inaccurate; or (iii) deletion of your personal data. You also have the right to object to the processing of your personal data on compelling legitimate grounds relating to your situation. Where we have obtained your consent for the processing of your personal data, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time.

Data We Collect by Automated Means – Cookies

We also collect certain data by using cookies when you visit this Site. Cookies are bits of text that are placed on your computer's hard drive or mobile device when you visit certain websites. Cookies hold data that may be accessed by the party that placed the cookie, which is either the Site itself (first party cookie) or a third party (third party cookie).

You do have control over cookies and can refuse the use of cookies by selecting the appropriate settings on your browser. Most browsers will tell you how to stop accepting new cookies, how to be notified when you receive a new cookie, and how to disable existing cookies. Please note, however, that by not accepting or deleting the use of cookies, you may not be able to (fully) use this Site.

On the Site, we use the following cookies:

JSESSIONID

This cookie is set when you get a session assigned from the server. We use this cookie for example to resolve whether you are logged in or not.

This cookie is saved until the session is ended (browser shut down).



preferreduserlanguage

This cookie is set when you choose to change the language of the Site. The next time you visit the Site we redirect you to your preferred language.

This cookie is saved for 1 year.

preferredCountry, preferredAssortment and preferredRegionalWebsite

These cookies are set when you choose to change your country (from within the cookie bar). The next time you visit the Site, we redirect you to your region website. Your preferred country is used when you reach out to us through the contact form on the Site (the country input select is prefilled with your chosen country).

This cookie is saved for 1 year.

Google Analytics: _ga, _gat, _utma, _utmz

These cookies are set when you visit the Site. Google Analytics is a web analytics service provided by Google, Inc., which uses cookies to help us with website statistics.

The data generated by the cookie about your use of this Site (such as your IP address, the URL visited, the date and time the page was viewed) will be transmitted via a secured connection (SSL) and stored by Google on servers in the United States. Your IP address will be masked by setting the last octet of your IP address to zero before it is stored by Google.

Google will use this data to monitor your use of this Site, and to compile reports on website activity for us. Based on our agreement with Google, Google is not allowed to use this data for their own purposes and may only transfer this data to third parties where required by law, or where such third parties process data on Google's behalf.

This cookie is saved for 1 year.
